### **Clackamas County, Portland Parks kick off planning for Boring Station, Springwater Corridor June 8**

Planning more than two miles of the Springwater Corridor is the focus of a design meeting at the Boring Station Trailhead Park site in Boring on Sunday, June 8, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Boring Farmers' Market, located between D Street and Highway 212 near the Boring Grange.

The proposed project begins at Rugg Road south of Boring and ends at Highway 212.

Clackamas County Parks and Portland Parks and Recreation are partnering on the Corridor design and the Boring Station Trailhead projects.

“This is a great opportunity for citizens of all ages to be a part in literally mapping the future of our area and of another beautiful recreational landmark,” said Clackamas County Commissioner Lynn Peterson. “These planning meetings give people a rare chance to help plan a park and trail. We hope to receive a lot of public input.”

A guided Springwater Corridor trail walk covering the entire 4.5-mile area will take place at 11 a.m. Walks will take place at the trail at 10:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m.

More meetings are being planned for summer, with details announced later. Citizen input and ideas will help shape the park site and trail for future use and enjoyment.
