

You are invited to the community kickoff for the Springwater Corridor design and Boring Station Trailhead Park planning projects at the Boring Farmers' Market!

Clackamas County Parks and Portland Parks and Recreation are working together to design and improve just more than 2 miles of trail along the Springwater Corridor. The proposed project begins at Rugg Road and continues south to Boring, ending at Highway 212. Clackamas County Parks is also working on developing a trailhead park between D Street and Highway 212 in Boring.

We will work with the community to complete a concept plan to determine future improvements to the trailhead site and to develop the design for the Springwater Corridor Trail. Interested citizens are encouraged to participate in these projects by attending the planning meetings or submitting comments via mail, e-mail or telephone. Submitted comments will be presented at public meetings.
